The duration of fellowship is for a period of two years, subject to review after one year, extendable for one more year.

Qualification: M.Sc. / M.Tech. / M.V.Sc or Integrated BS-MS in any branch of Life Sciences with two years research experience in working on isolation, characterization of active principles from medicinal plants and their evaluation for anti-inflammatory properties.

Hands on experience in Molecular Biology, Cell Culture, HPLC and Mass Spectrometry are preferable.
