Eligibility: Three-year graduate degree in Biomedical Engineering/Life Sciences with three years of post-qualification experience, OR Postgraduate degree in Biomedical Engineering/Life Sciences, OR Four-year graduate degree in Engineering (Biomedical)

Desirable Experience: Candidate with hands-on experience in monoclonal antibodies, biosensing, materials science, organoids and 3-D printing will be preferred. Candidates having prior experience in working with the development of in-vitro models/monoclonal antibodies is desirable.
